Medication Review

Rescue medications

- Taken as needed when a patient has symptoms (i.e. shortness of breath)
- Examples
 - Short-acting beta-agonists (SABA)
 - Albuterol
 - Short-acting muscarinic antagonists (SAMA)
 - Ipratropium

Medication Review

Maintenance medications

- Taken everyday, regardless of how the patient is feeling

Examples

- Long-acting beta-agonists (LABA)
 - Formoterol (Foradil)
- Long-acting muscarinic antagonists (LAMA)
 - Tiotropium (Spiriva)
- Inhaled corticosteroids (ICS)
 - Fluticasone (Flovent)
- Roflumilast
- Theophylline

Combination Products

Rescue Medications

- Albuterol/Ipratropium
 - Inhaler: Combivent[®]
 - Nebulizer: Duoneb[®]

Maintenance Medications

- ICS/LABA
 - UTM Formulary: Mometasone/Formoterol (Dulera[®])
- LAMA/LABA
 - UTM Non-formulary: Umeclidinium/Vilanterol (Anoro Elipta[®])

 - Indication
 - General administration
 - Adverse effects

- Review materials with patient for their anticipated **home** COPD medications
